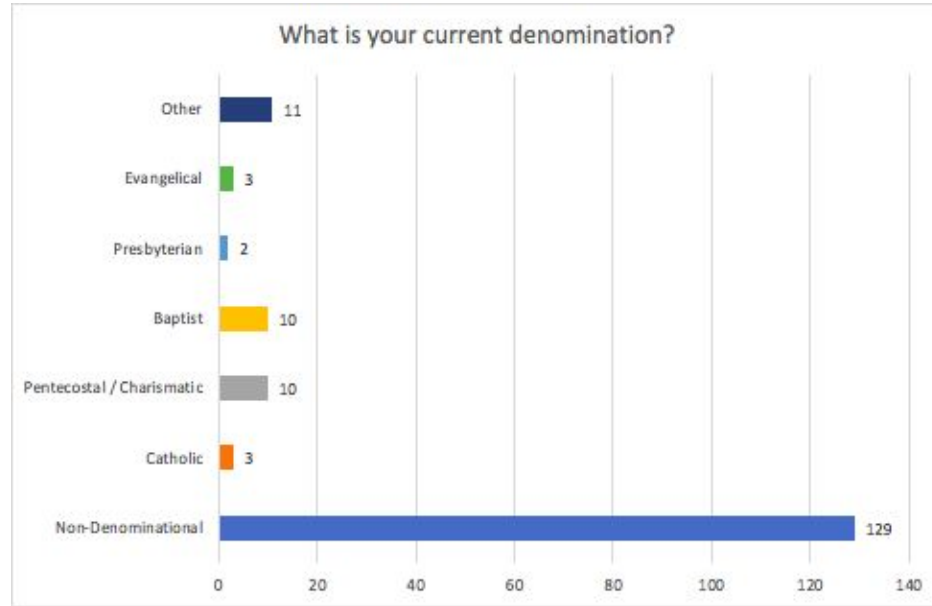

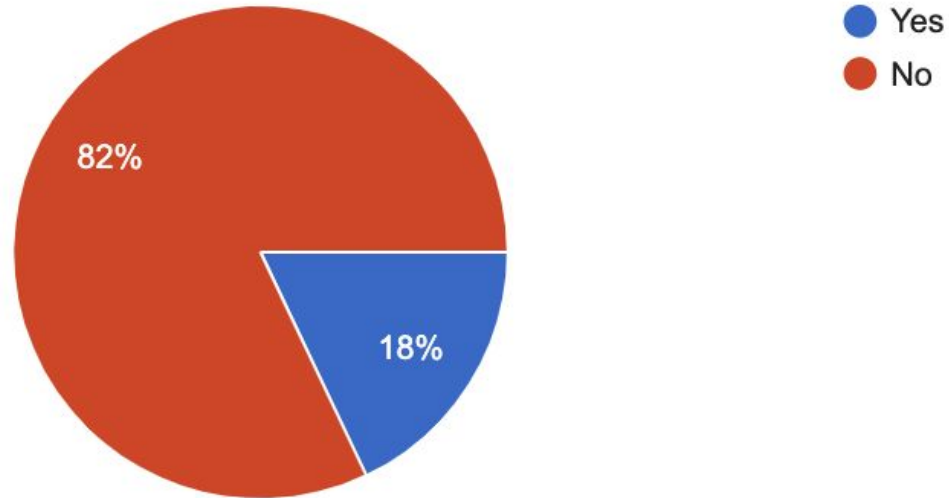
Initial Demographic Breakdown - Denomination

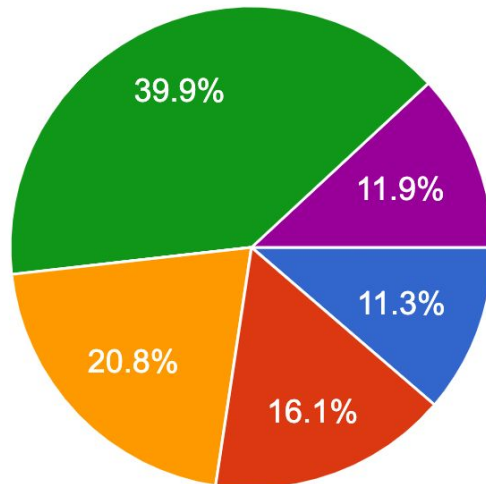

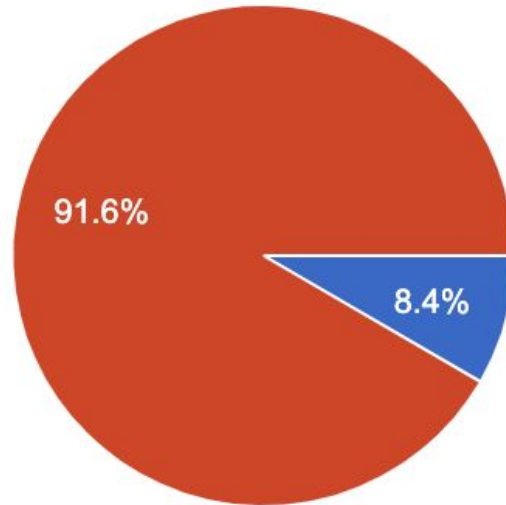

167 responses



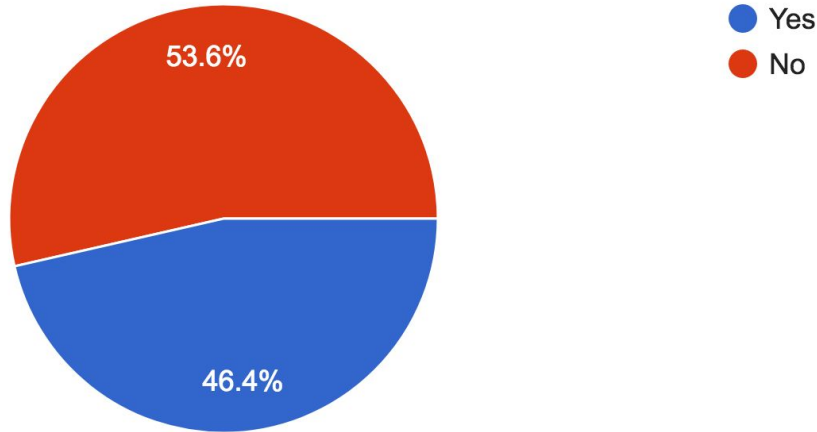
● Yes

Underclassmen haven't heard of the Pour-Out Chapels

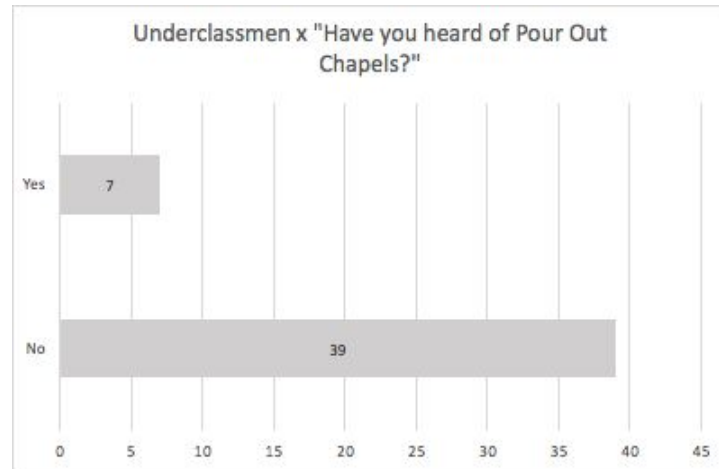
Major Finding 2-Underclassmen haven't heard of the Pour-Out Chapels

Major Finding 3 - Top 5 Desired Topics of the Holy Spirit

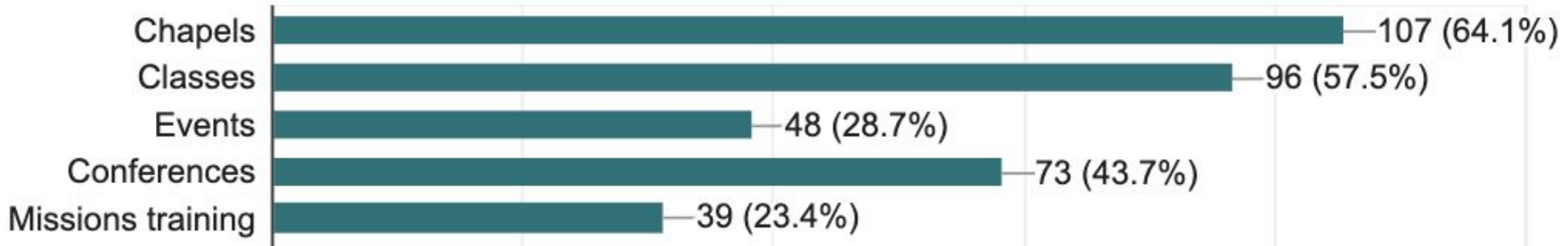
1. Discerning Voice/Guiding Us - **117** Respondents

Major Finding 4 - Preferred ways to learn about Holy Spirit

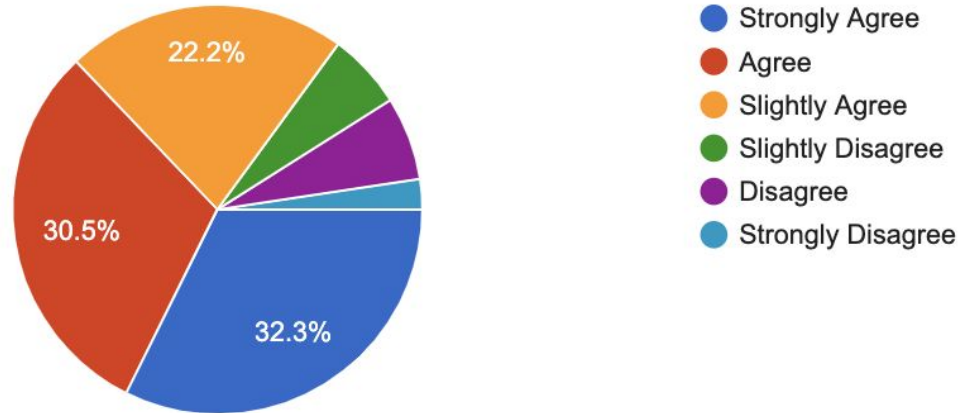


85% of Students want a Pneumatology Class

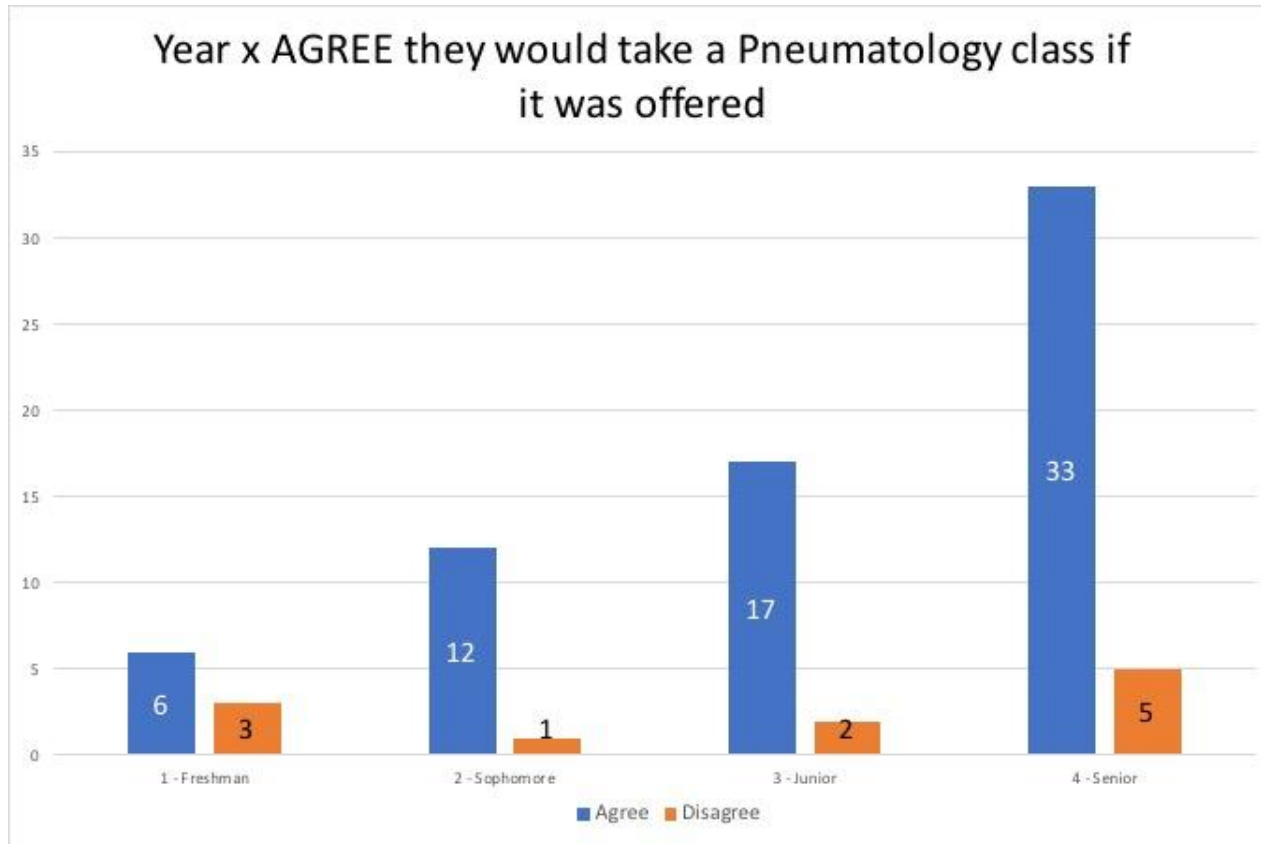
"If Biola offered a Pneumatology (study of the Holy Spirit) class that addressed relevant topics , I would definitely take it."

Breakdown by Grade of Students that want a Pneumatology Class— 79 Total



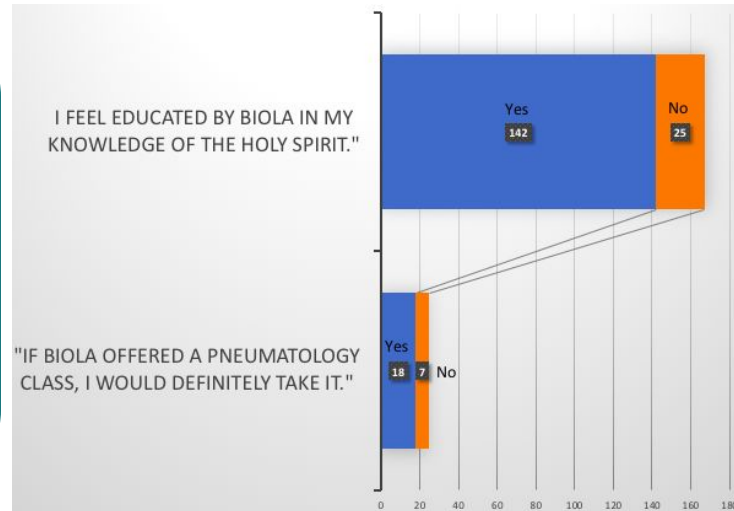
Those who feel uneducated wish there was a class

Of the 25 survey respondents who don't feel that Biola has educated them on the Holy Spirit, **18 of them AGREE** that they would **take a Pneumatology class** if it was offered at Biola.

- Conduct research with current attendees of Coffee and Chat and see how to improve it

- Allow more time to garner more survey respondents



Limitations

- Short time to distribute and analyze survey
- Survey promotion was only done online
- Demographic base was heavily influenced by people who knew the surveyors
